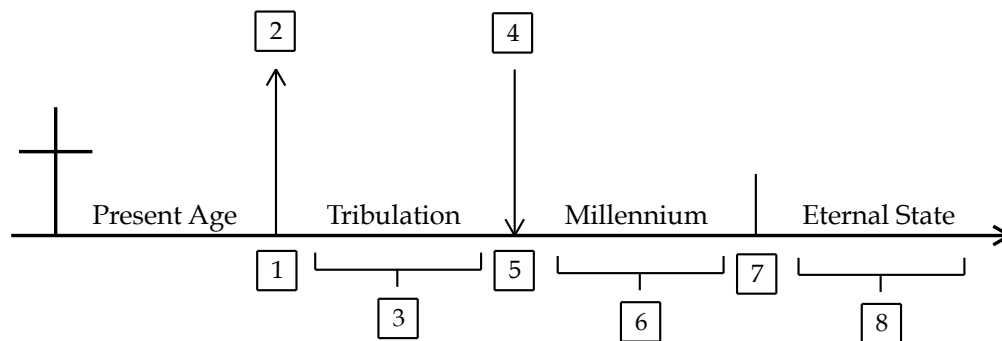

2. Joy in the Midst of Trials (1 Pet 1:3-6)
3. Patience in the Throes of Affliction (James 5:7-11)
4. Perseverance in the Face of Persecution (2 Thess 1:3-10)
5. Zeal in Devotion to Discipleship (Heb 10:24-25)
6. Faithfulness in Service to God (Matt 24:42-51; 25:1-13; 25:14-30)
7. Hope in a World of Corruption (Rom 8:18-25; 2 Cor 4:16-18)
8. Comfort in a Season of Grief (1 Thess 4:13-18)
9. Amazement at the Wisdom of God (Rom 11:33-36)
10. Diligence in Ministry to Others (1 Pet 4:7-11)
11. Encouragement in an Age of Darkness (1 Thess 5:1-11)
12. Steadfastness in the Work of the Lord (1 Cor 15:50-58)
